

## **Ammanuel Church COVID 19 Updates Jan 14<sup>th</sup>, 2022**

### **Health Department**

In the last two weeks, **28.8 percent of COVID-19 tests** in Philadelphia have come back **positive**.

Philadelphia is averaging **3,301 new cases** of COVID-19 per day over the last two weeks

**78.4** percent of Philadelphia adults are fully vaccinated, and more than **95 percent** of Philadelphia adults have received at least one dose of COVID-19 vaccine.

**5-11 years** vaccinated are **30.4%** in Philadelphia

**1,621** are hospitalized and **126** use ventilators in Philadelphia

### **Booster shots**

**Anyone 12 or older can get a booster dose after they've completed their COVID vaccine series.**

To get a booster, you'll need to show your vaccine card or a photo of your vaccine card. If you've lost your card, [you can request a replacement](#).

### **Religious Institute Guidance**

#### **Philadelphia mask mandate**

Philadelphia's **mask mandate went into effect on August 12, 2021** to combat the COVID-19 emergency in Philadelphia.

- **Masks will be required indoors at all Philadelphia businesses, institutions, and event venues.**
- Businesses, institutions, and event venues **that require vaccination** for all employees and patrons are **exempted from having a mask requirement.**
- Businesses, institutions, and event venues that **do not require everyone who enters to be vaccinated, must require everyone on site to wear a mask** except only:

- When actively eating and drinking while seated or at a standing table of no more than four people.
- Anyone who is not seated or at a table may not eat and/or drink.
- If any individual is unvaccinated, everyone in the institution must be masked when the masked, unvaccinated person is present, no matter the reason the person is unvaccinated.

## Signages

### Safety checklist



#### Masks

Block the virus from spreading from infected persons by wearing masks and requiring others to wear them.



#### Barriers

Use sneeze guards or plexiglass screens to prevent respiratory droplets expelled by infected persons from reaching others.



#### Isolate

Keep people who might be carrying the virus safely away from others (ideally at home).



#### Distance

Maintain space between people to reduce the chance that one infected individual will infect others.



#### Reduce crowds

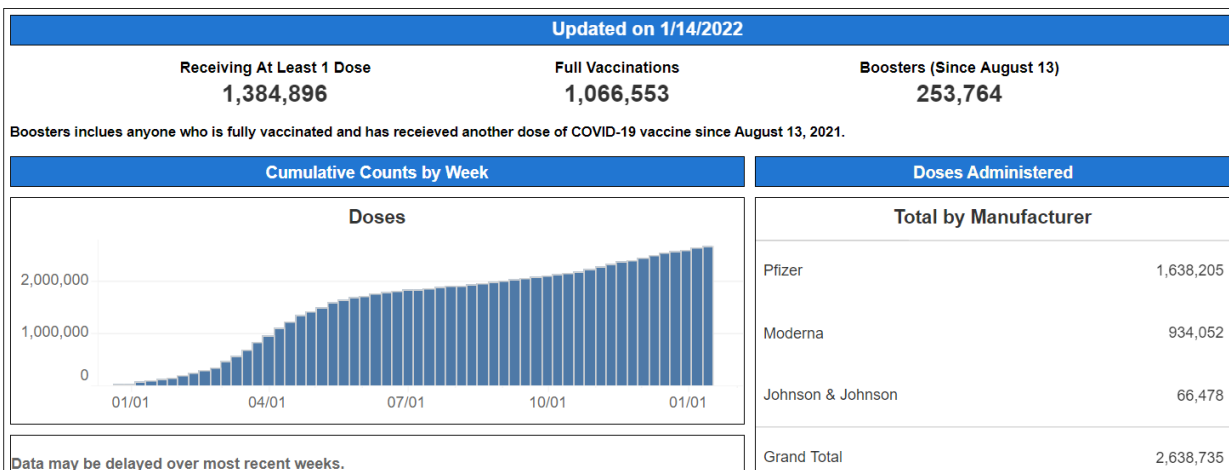
Decrease the number of people that an infected person could pass the virus to if other steps are not successful.



#### Handwashing

Reduce the spread of virus from one person to another from touching contaminated surfaces.
