

Ammanuel Church COVID 19 Updates May 6th, 2022

CDC

The United States is finally "**out of the pandemic phase**, as cases and hospitalizations are notably down, and mask mandates are all but extinct.

Restrictions, too, are easing as many Americans appear to be putting the pandemic behind them.

Masking requirements have been lifted across most of the country, and officials stopped enforcing a federal mask mandate in transportation settings after a judge struck down the requirement.

Variant

Viruses constantly change through mutation and sometimes these mutations result in a new variant of the virus. Some variants emerge and disappear while others persist. New variants will continue to emerge

Symptoms

People with COVID-19 have had a wide range of symptoms reported – ranging from mild symptoms to severe illness. Symptoms may appear 2-14 days after exposure to the virus. Anyone can have mild to severe symptoms. People with these symptoms may have COVID-19:

- Fever or chills
- Cough
- Shortness of breath or difficulty breathing
- Fatigue
- Muscle or body aches
- Headache
- New loss of taste or smell
- Sore throat
- Congestion or runny nose
- Nausea or vomiting
- Diarrhea

Health Department

All residents ages five and older are eligible to be vaccinated in Philadelphia.

When and where is it “strongly recommended” to mask?

- Any time you or a family member are going into an environment where the people present are more likely to have health risks, **like a nursing home.**
- In a small space with multiple people, **like a carpool.**
- In a location with multiple people entering and exiting, **like a train, bus, or grocery store.**
- Any time you or your family member are around **individuals who are not or cannot be vaccinated, like daycare or preschools.**
- When you or a family member are in an **indoor space with many other people that involves physical exertion, like the gym.**

Other settings

Even without a City mandate, all residents and visitors are permitted and **encouraged to wear a mask in any setting they choose.**

Businesses and other institutions are allowed to be stricter than the City’s COVID-19 policies, so some businesses may require proof of vaccination or require that everyone wears a mask.

Schools may set their own mask policies, and it is strongly encouraged that students and teachers continue to keep each other safe by wearing a mask.

Masks will continue to be required in healthcare settings and **congregate settings such as nursing homes and shelters.**

“As we’ve learned more about COVID-19 and how it affects us in Philadelphia, the Health Department has **adjusted the City’s mandates to be the least restrictive while keeping residents safe**

Weekly COVID-19 Response Level: This week’s COVID-19 response level is Level 1: “**All Clear**” means no mask requirement except for healthcare center, congregate, **But those who are unvaccinated required to wear double mask and those who are in high-risk people.**

What will be required to reach All Clear Status?

All Clear Status

- Average new daily case count is under **100**
- Hospitalizations are under **50**
- Positivity is under **2%**
- Cases have not risen by more than **50%** within the past 10 days

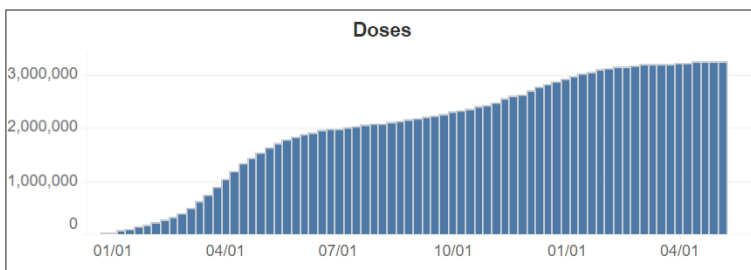
People Who Were Fully Vaccinated in Philadelphia

Cumulative Counts by Week

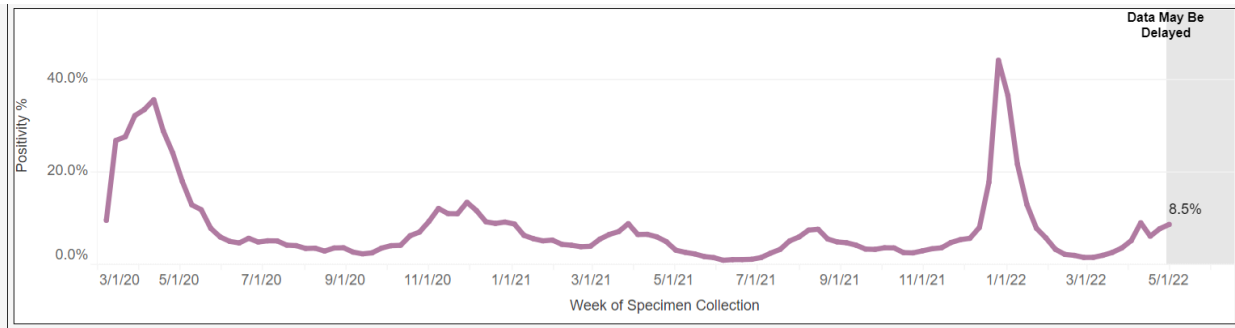
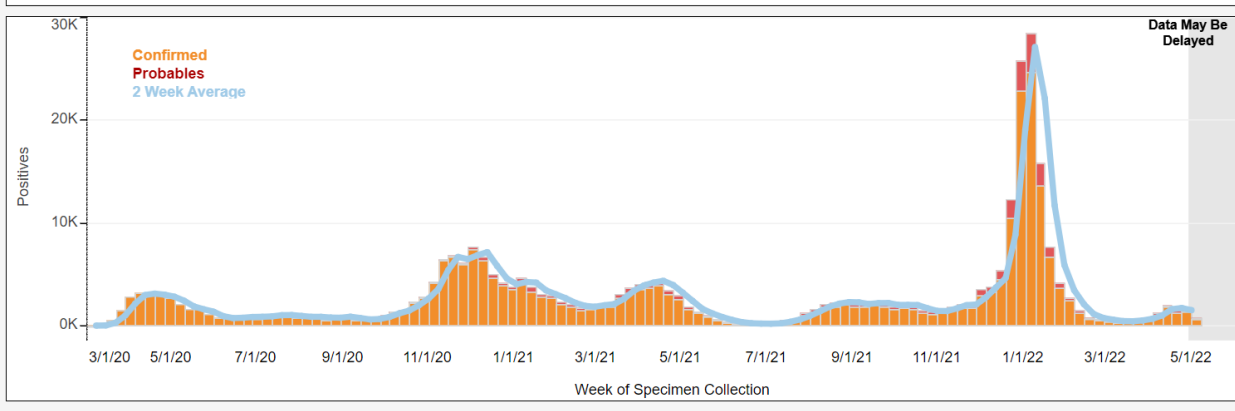

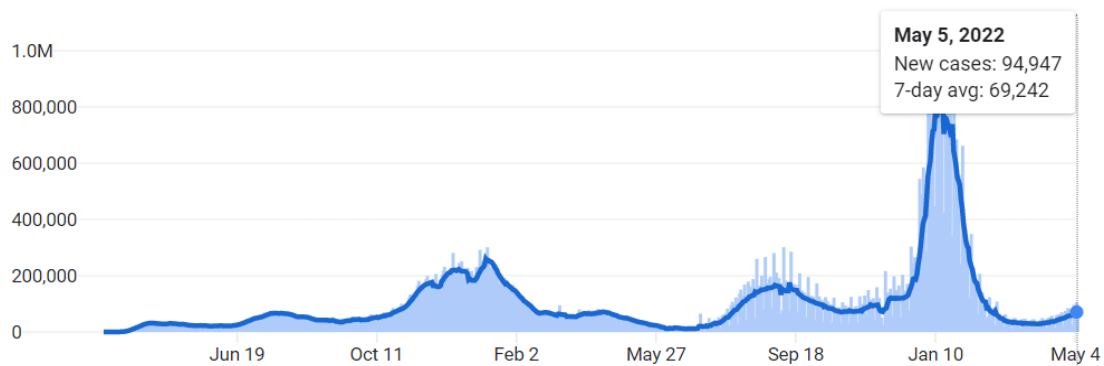
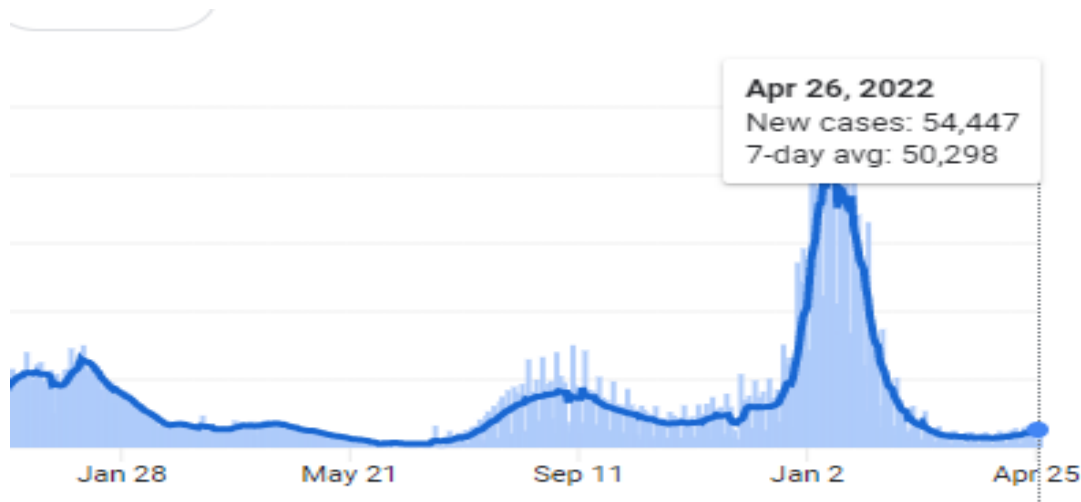
